This tour of the historic sites associated with the origins of the Pilgrim Fathers, provides time to take a look at the peaceful villages and sites which gave birth to the founders of a great nation.

### Highlights Included in Your Tour

**All Saints Church, Babworth.** The origins of religious separatism are closely linked with the rectory and church of Babworth. Richard Clyfton, William Brewster and William Bradford have connections here.

**Lincoln Castle,** this imposing Norman castle is the home of the Magna Carta, the document credited with being the basis of the Constitution of America.

**St. Wilfrid's Church, Scrooby.** The church lies in the centre of the village, childhood home of William Brewster.

**Scrooby Manor House.** William Brewster inherited the appointment of bailiff to the Archbishop's estates and lived in the Manor House. Brewster's home became the meeting place for the nonconformists.

**Boston Guildhall Museum,** where we visit the cells which reportedly held the pilgrims.

**Boston 'Stump' Church,** where monuments to John Cotton, who led his congregation to the New World and founded Boston, Massachusetts can be viewed.

**Fishtoft,** the point where the pilgrims set sail for Holland.
