Canterbury is an absolutely fascinating city boasting 3 World Heritage sites, all of which will be explored in this mouth watering tour.

Highlights Included in Your Tour

Canterbury Cathedral, a World Heritage site, is one of the finest Cathedrals in England and stands on one of the oldest sites of Christian worship in England.

St Augustine's Abbey Ruins – A hugely significant location in terms of Christian Heritage and once the burial place for the Anglo-Saxon kings of Kent. This is also one of the Canterbury World Heritage Sites.

Greyfriars Friary, is the only building now remaining of the first English Franciscan Friary.

Eastbridge Hospital, a former hostel for pilgrims to the Cathedral with an outstanding undercroft and hall and 14th Century chapel.

St Martin's Church is the oldest church in the English speaking world still used for worship. It encompasses

impressive Norman and Saxon features. The third World Heritage Site in Canterbury!

Walking Tour looking at the fascinating historic buildings including Queen Elizabeth's Guest Chamber, the Old Weavers House, the Tudor House and Conquest House. Walk on the old City walls and explore the Norman castle whilst listening to tales of Chaucer & Charles Dickens.

Visit to the Roman Museum which is set below street level. See the reconstructions of Roman shops, the market place and an original mosaic floor in situ.
